Scripture for the week:

After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go. Luke 10 v 1 NIV

 words that we speak, will be the words directly from the throne of grace, His words filled
 with the power of the Holy Spirit and that as in the days of Peter and John, that people
 will see that we have been with Jesus.

Tuesday - Praying ahead of Thursday's Telephone Day
